PRACTICE TEACHING B.A. 6^{TH} SEMESTER 2022-2023 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, DAMDAMA COLLEGE

In the academic session 2022-23, the Department of Education, Damdama College organized extension activity for the 6th semester students. The total no. 15 students from 6th semester who has opted for SEC subject under Gauhati University were taught about practice teaching and teaching skills.

Under the guidance of Miss Anisha Choudhury, Assistant Professor and Dr. Gitamani Deka, Assistant Professor, Damdama College the students were sent to different schools which was assigned by the HoD, Education Department namely Pachgaon HS School, Gerua and Chechamukh High School located in Hajo, Kamrup District. The students were assigned one school each for practice teaching for a week (7days). Each student has selected the subjects of their own interest for practice in the schools. Before teaching, the students prepared lesson plan of the subject content which was to be taught in the class and prepared class dairy each day which was duly signed by the Head Master of the Schools. The students taught different subjects like Social Science, Assamese, and Mathematics of class VI, VII, VIII for a week (7days) by using different types of teaching skills like introduction, questioning, blackboard, illustration, and simulation and by using teaching aids. Each student taught in the classroom for minim one hour and maximum two hour per day in their assigned schools.

Outcome:

The students gained first hand on experience of teaching in the real classroom which gave them confidence, enhance their teaching skills, communication skills, leadership qualities and to build a rapport with the students which they can apply in their career. Practice teaching has helped the students to gain the knowledge of professional ethics.
