Assessment tools and process for course outcome attainment

The institution follows direct assessment technique for the evaluation of course outcome, which includes Internal assessment and University Assessment. The internal assessment is conducted for 20% of marks in each paper. As per the space provided in the academic calendar of the affiliating university, a routine (centrally) is prepared by the institution, where written examination is held for 10% of marks. Further, a two-stage evaluation process has been adopted by the institute for the remaining 10% marks. Maximum 4% marks are allotted to student's attendance. While the remaining 6% marks are allotted to performance of students in different activities like group discussion, seminar presentation, survey or extra-curricular performances etc. Additionally, occasional tests are also conducted by the departments on the completion of syllabus.
