

4.4.2 - There are established systems and procedures for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities - laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc.

The college has maintained a systematic procedure for the proper utilization of academic and physical facilities available. There is a working register to record the classes properly for each department on a regular basis. The traditional method of teaching-learning is used to conduct the classes smoothly, such as chalk and blackboard, lecture and discussion, demonstration, and ICT classes, for the greater benefit of students. The college has at present 971 students, and according to the needs, the college has the required classrooms and required numbers of books in the central library i.e. more than 16000 books, and the students get the opportunity to use them as much as per their requirements. The two laboratories were also used to conduct classes on ICT and psychological practical's of education.

The playground and open space of the college have been used for outdoor games. The large hall of the colleges has been used for conducting seminars in hybrid mode, cultural programs, academic meetings, and group discussions. The college authority supervises the maintenance and utilization of all these facilities, off and on organize formal meetings where stakeholders are invited to make aware of the benefit of the use of these facilities.
